Several years later, he became the Director of the National Center on Deafness (NCOD) at California State University, Northridge in 1979 and worked till retirement in 1998. He was a great GLAD Board president, and Patricia had the opportunity to work with him when she first joined GLAD in 2003 for a year. She could remember the first day she arrived here as the GLAD's new CEO, he picked her up at the airport and wanted to go out for lunch. He then told me that he was not familiar with restaurants in Burbank or here in Eagle Rock. He asked if she wouldn't mind dining at McDonald's. She didn't mind so they ended up eating at McDonald's and it was one of the best lunches she had because it was with him and Patricia Hughes with his witty sense of humor.

He was a very gracious person presiding over the GLAD board. We thank him for his years of contribution and continuous support of GLAD over the years. Patricia had the pleasure of working with him during this time before he retired from the board. May his family be comforted during this time of grief and cherish the memories of Herb and his life.
