Diploma or Certificate

Students earn a diploma or certificate by completing all the educational requirements set by their school, district, city, and state. Typical requirements include English, math, social studies, science, physical education, and vocational skills such as arts, home economics, woodshop, etc.

Graduation ceremony

The ceremony may include a procession, greetings, speeches, presentations, and music. The procession may include the singing of the national anthem, speeches, and graduating class. Greetings may include introductions from the principal and board. Speeches may be given by student speakers such as Valedictorian, Salutatorian, and guest speakers. Presentations may include the awarding of diplomas. The ceremony may end with more music and graduates marching and lining up for hands shaking.






1) 1984- 25 graduating students


2) 1978-23 graduating students
