**Remember The Past...**

On Jan. 10, 1975, Omaha was crippled by a blizzard, part of a larger storm that suffocated the Midwest with wind and snow that hurled tornadoes across the southeast. It dumped between 11 to 16 inches of

snow on metro Omaha. Seventy people died, 58 because of the blizzard and 12 from the tornadoes. In Iowa, 17 died; in Nebraska, 14; and in the Dakotas, Minnesota and Wisconsin, 27.

It happened on Friday when NSD students were supposed to go home. Unfortunately, many students did not have a chance to go home for the weekend. Only few students were able to go home for the weekend. Unusually, NSD had a large number of students staying on the campus for the weekend. During blizzard weekend, many students were playing in the snow, sledding and making snowmen. Also, we watched some open-captioned movies and played carnival games. The staff and houseparent were trying to find activities to keep every student busy for three days. By Monday, all the streets had been plowed and school was back to normal schedule again.
